As of the most recent available data (January 05, 2024), 2.9% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 3.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 2.1% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 4.7% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 05, 2024), 1.9% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 1.9% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 4.7% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 5.0% fewer credits.
