As of the most recent available data (January 08, 2024), 3.7% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 4.1% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 2.1% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 4.7% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 08, 2024), 4.5% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 4.5% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 4.7% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 5.0% fewer credits.
