As of the most recent available data (**November 18, 2025**), **1.2% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **2.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **18.6% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2025 January Intersession, and this constitutes **14.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 18, 2025**), **29.3% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **24.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **48.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2025 January Intersession, and this constitutes **47.9% fewer** credits.
