As of the most recent available data (**November 19, 2025**), **0.6% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **3.3% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **18.1% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2025 January Intersession, and this constitutes **13.4% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 19, 2025**), **36.7% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **32.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **45.7% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2025 January Intersession, and this constitutes **44.9% fewer** credits.
