As of the most recent available data (**November 24, 2025**), **0.2% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **4.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **13.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2025 January Intersession, and this constitutes **7.9% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 24, 2025**), **2.4% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **1.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **35.7% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2025 January Intersession, and this constitutes **35.3% fewer** credits.
