As of the most recent available data (**December 02, 2025**), **3.3% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **0.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **8.6% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2025 January Intersession, and this constitutes **3.2% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 02, 2025**), **3.7% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2025 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **3.4% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **27.9% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2026 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2025 January Intersession, and this constitutes **27.8% fewer** credits.
