#### **Changes to This Year's SFA Component**

- SFA is now part of the Winter collection. The Winter collection will close for keyholders on February 8, 2012.

- For reporting grant or scholarship aid, institutions should report "aid awarded" rather than "aid received" or "aid awarded and accepted." The amount awarded may be different from the amount that was actually disbursed to students. There is no change to how loans to students should be reported. - Veterans education benefits should no longer be reported in SFA, as they are no longer considered Estimated Financial Assistance for Federal Student Aid purposes.


