#### CAVEATS

For the current and subsequent reporting years, CUNY institutions count students as completers only if they earned the degree at the college at which they first enrolled. Students are counted as persisters only if they are enrolled at their first college at the end of the tracking period. Students who transfer to another CUNY college (regardless of whether they graduated or remain enrolled) are counted as transfers out. In prior years, CUNY institutions credited the initial institution with a completion when a student transferred within the CUNY system and completed a degree at another CUNY college. The change in methodology produces a slightly lower graduation rate, and a higher transfer out rate.
