2019-20 Recent Graduate Survey *Brief Summary of Items*

Summary of Responses, 2019-20 Brooklyn College Recent Graduate Survey

Brooklyn College administered the 2019-20 Recent Graduate Survey to students who earned degrees in the summer 2019, fall 2019, or spring 2020 semesters. The survey opened on September 29, 2020, and closed on February 16, 2021. Of 4,091 recent graduates who were contacted to participate in this survey, 1,065 completed it, for a response rate of 26.0%. Below are some highlights.

Pursuit of Further Education:

- 77.8% of students completing undergraduate degrees and 46.4% of students completing graduate degrees had plans to continue further education beyond their degree.
- Of those who indicated that they planned to pursue further education, the most common subject matter area for further education was in the field of Education. This was true for students completing undergraduate and graduate degrees.
- Of those who indicated that they planned to pursue further education, the most common degree sought by students completing undergraduate degrees was a Master's degree. Among students completing graduate degrees, the most common degree sought was a Ph.D.

Internship Experiences:

- 29.5% of recent graduates who had completed an undergraduate degree indicated that they had an internship while attending Brooklyn College.
 - Of those recent graduates who completed an undergraduate degree who also had an internship, 49.2% had at least one paid internship. 70.5% had at least one unpaid internship.
- 30.3% of recent graduates who had completed a graduate degree indicated that they had an internship while attending Brooklyn College.
 - Of those recent graduates who completed an undergraduate degree who also had an internship, 29.7% had at least one paid internship. 79.7% had at least one unpaid internship.

Post-Graduate Employment:

- Among recent graduates who completed an undergraduate degree, 64.1% of respondents were currently employed. 41.9% were employed in full-time positions. Some characteristics of the jobs they hold:
 - o 57.7% work for a business or for-profit organization.
 - o 87.3% are employed in New York City.
 - o 40.8% started at this job within the past year.
 - o 27.5% work in Educational Instruction or Library Occupations.
 - o 21.5% have employees that report to them.
 - o 50.8% believe that their current job is a career position.
 - o 67.4% believe that their current job is related to the major they pursued at Brooklyn College.
 - 44.2% report that Brooklyn College prepared them "well" or "very well" for their current job.

- o 13.6% already earn as much as, or more than, the median household income of Brooklyn (approximately \$60,000 in 2019*).
- Among recent graduates who completed a graduate degree, 77.8% of respondents were currently employed. 63.6%% were employed in full-time positions. Some characteristics of the jobs they hold:
 - o 58.4% work for the government, or a publicly funded organization other than the military.
 - o 87.8% are employed in New York City.
 - o 30.1% started at this job within the past year.
 - o 64.2% work in Educational Instruction or Library Occupations.
 - o 18.6% have employees that report to them.
 - o 78.2% believe that their current job is a career position.
 - 89.8% believe that their current job is related to the major they pursued at Brooklyn College.
 - o 57.1% report that Brooklyn College prepared them "well" or "very well" for their current job.
 - o 53.4% already earn as much as, or more than, the median household income of Brooklyn (approximately \$60,000 in 2019*).

Student Learning Outcomes:

- Respondents who had completed an undergraduate degree at Brooklyn College reported that the College had prepared them well, or very well, to do the following:
 - o To think critically and creatively: 68.0%.
 - To effectively express your thoughts: 68.8%.
 - o To make sound ethical judgments: 69.2%.
 - o To integrate knowledge from diverse sources: 73.3%.
 - o To become an informed and responsible citizen of the world: 73.0%.
- Respondents who had completed a graduate degree at Brooklyn College reported that the College had prepared them well, or very well, to do the following:
 - o To think critically and creatively: 71.7%.
 - o To effectively express your thoughts: 70.9%.
 - To make sound ethical judgments: 70.5%.
 - o To integrate knowledge from diverse sources: 73.9%.
 - o To become an informed and responsible citizen of the world: 70.7%.
