

Brooklyn College Department-Specific Analysis

Students Enrolled in Biology 52.2 Since Fall 2001

Here are some comments that may be useful for interpreting this table.

- There are three purposes of this table:
 - To identify the students taking Biology 52.2 in each semester since Fall 2001.
 - To identify the major the student had at the time in which he or she was enrolled in the class.
 - To identify the current situation of that student in regard to the completion of his or her degree.
- Under “Term and Student’s Major During That Term”, there are two kinds of headings:
 - Headings in bold indicating the semester in question.
 - Sub-headings indicating the major of the students enrolled during that semester.
- For each row, going across, there is a count of the students who took the course that semester who were enrolled in that major for each of the characteristics presented in the other columns. The semester rows contain the sum of students tallied in the student major sub-headings in the rows directly below them.
- The names of majors includes the title of the major, the type of degree (BA or BS), and the Brooklyn College major code.
- Going across, the table presents the following information on each group of students:
- The total count of students enrolled in the course for that semester.
 - The initial count, which indicates the number of students who enrolled in Biology 52.2 that semester.
 - The count of those students who have since graduated with a bachelor’s degree in Biology.
 - The count of those students who have since graduated with a bachelor’s degree in another science field (other sciences include Chemistry, Environmental Science, Geology, Mathematics, and Physics).
 - The count of those students who have since graduated with a bachelor’s degree in a non-science field.
 - The count of those students who have not graduated, and are currently enrolled as Biology majors.
 - The count of those students who have not graduated, and are currently enrolled as majors in another science.
 - The count of those students who have not graduated, and are currently enrolled, but not as science majors.
 - The count of those students who have not graduated and are not currently enrolled.
- “Current” enrollment is as of the Spring 2006 semester.
- A total was not provided. This is because students taking the course in one semester may have taken the course again in another; thus, a total could double-count some students.
