Note: The Following Abbreviations Were Used in This Table:

AINA refers to American Indian and Native Alaskan.

API refers to Asian or Pacific Islander.

BNH refers to Black, Non-Hispanic.

HIS refers to Hispanic.

WNH refers to White, Non-Hispanic.

MIS refers to Missing, and refers to students for whom ethnicity is not identified.

Total is the total for all students in the table.

NM is the total for all students, minus those with missing ethnicity.

URM refers to Underrepresented Minorities, a category including all American Indians and Native Alaskans, Black Non-Hispanics, and Hispanics.

Indication that a degree is a BA or BS is offered only in instances where two majors have the same name, and the difference is which degree is awarded. For example, for Biology BA and Biology BS.
