4. All Students refers to any student who enrolled as a first time, full time, baccalaureate degree-seeking freshmen in Fall 2000.

4. All Students refers to any student who enrolled as a full time, baccalaureate degree-seeking transfer student entering between Fall 2000 and Fall 2002.
