



One Semester Retention

As continued emphasis on academic progress of the Brooklyn College students, one of our many efforts and focuses is placed on research and data analyses pertaining to retention and graduation rates. This analysis will examine the one-semester retention/persistence rates of Fall 2004 and Spring 2005 for only degree students. (The data sources are: Fall 2004 and Spring 2005 show files, Fall 2004 graduation file, and National Student Clearinghouse file.)

Retention and Persistence

Terms and definitions:

Retained – students enrolled in one semester (fall) who returned in another (spring)

Not retained – students who did not return in another semester

Not enrolled – those who were not retained and who did not graduate

Retention rate – percent of students who returned

Graduation rate – percent of students who earned degrees

Persistence rate – percent of students who returned or graduated

Part of evaluating student academic progress is to measure the retention and graduation rates. Retention rate demonstrates how many students are retained and graduation rate indicates how many retained students successfully earned their degrees within a period of time. It is important to take persistence rate into consideration when we estimate our success in academic performance. It is also crucial to use persistence rates when we attempt to compare retention rates if graduation rates are different between the student groups.

Some key findings [refer to attachment 1]:

- The overall retention rate for all degree students is 81.4%.
- Entering freshman's retention rate is 91.6%.
- Transfers have an 82.8% retention rate.
- Entering graduate students show a 90.0% retention rate.

- The overall persistence rate for all degree students is 86.0%.
- Full-time degree students have a higher persistence rate than part-time degree students (90.4% and 79.9%). There are 4.4% and -6.1%, respectively, differences from the overall rate; there is a 10.5% difference between these two groups.
- Undergraduate degree students have a slightly lower persistence rate (85.4%) than graduate degree students (87.7%). There are -0.6% and 1.7%, respectively,

differences from the overall rate; there is a 2.3% difference between these two groups.

- The persistence rate for entering freshmen is 91.6%, for transfers is 82.8%, and for entering graduate students is 90.0%. The differences from the overall rate are 5.6%, -3.2%, and 4.0%, respectively.

This analysis shows that part-time students have a lower persistence rate than the overall students. It may not be too surprisingly, for these students often are less “committed” because of external factors such as job and/or family responsibilities. Another noticeable group is the transfers. The persistence rate for this group, among various groups, is much lower than the overall rate. More detailed analyses will be needed, in particular the transfers, to examine factors that are correlated with retention and persistence to evaluate our academic performance.

Transferred Schools

Of the non-retained, the National Student Clearinghouse has identified 293 students with their transferred schools. Most of these students have transferred to Kingsborough Community College (20.5%), followed by Hunter College (7.8%), New York City Technical College (6.8%), Baruch College (6.5%), and Touro College (6.1%). [Refer to attachments II and III.]

The top five transferred schools for the full-time students are: Kingsborough Community College (24.1%), Baruch College (9.1%), Hunter College (9.1%), New York City Technical College (6.4%), and Touro College (4.3%). For the part-time students, they are: Kingsborough Community College (14.2%), Touro College (9.4%), New York City Technical College (7.5%), Long Island University-Brooklyn (6.6%), and Hunter College (5.7%). [Refer to attachment IV.]

The most selected transferred college for graduate students is Touro College (17.9%), and for undergraduate students is Kingsborough Community College (23.6%). For entering students, the most selected choice of the freshmen is Kingsborough Community College (14.3%), transfers is also Kingsborough Community College (17.6%), and graduate students is Touro College (15.0%). [Refer to attachments V and VI.]

In addition to gaining information about to where our students have transferred, the National Student Clearinghouse data may be used as a “transfer-rate” measure. The transfer rate here is defined as the percent of students with identified schools within those students who did not enroll in the subsequent semester.

The overall transfer rate for degree students is 14.5%. There is a 7.3% difference between the undergraduates (16.1%) and the graduates (8.8%). Among the entering students, the freshmen have the highest rate (27.5%), followed by the transfers (19.9%) and graduate students (19.0%). The big difference in rates is shown between full-time students and part-time students (23.4% and 8.7%). The low transfer rate of the part-time students perhaps, as mentioned earlier, suggests their “less commitment.” [Refer to attachment VII.]

This is an exploratory analysis to provide some insight and indication on our students’ academic progress. It serves as a stimulant for discussions and more studies. We need to further examine various components associated with retention and persistence to improve upon our goal of academic excellence.

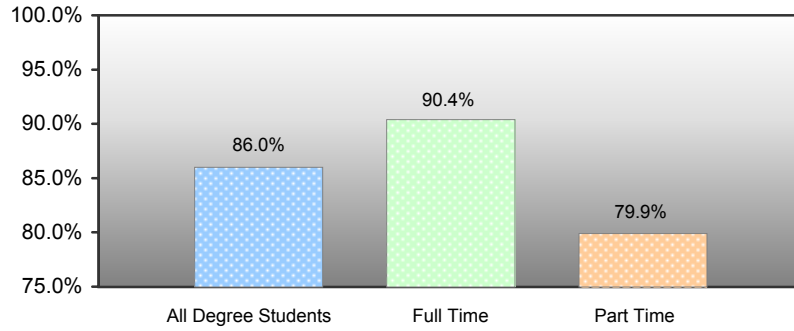

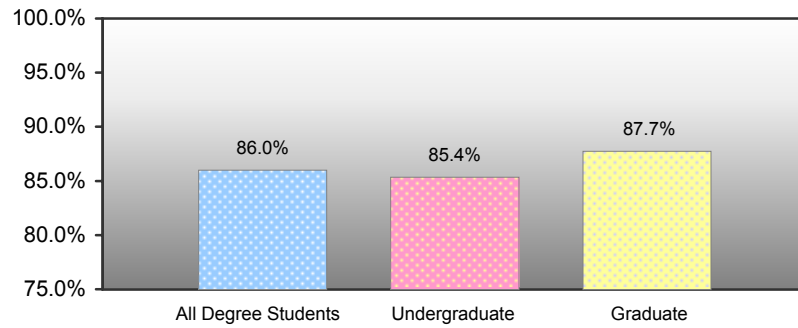

(Fall 2004 - Spring 2005)

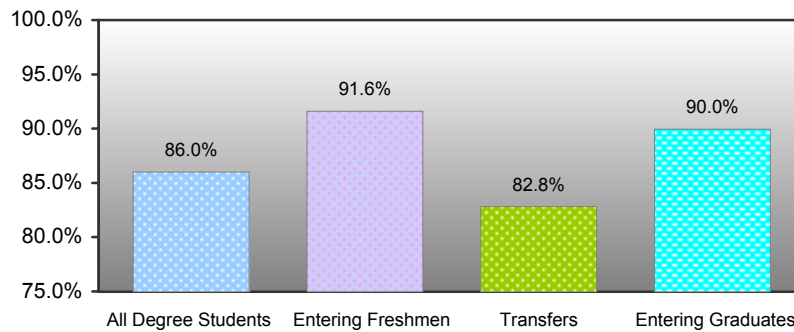
Full Time and Part Time
