

Undergraduate Final Examination Schedule Fall 2017

Final examinations for the fall 2017 semester will be held from **Wednesday, December 13, through Wednesday, December 20**. Final examinations have been scheduled based on uniform examinations (in the bold print below) and the section of the course. A copy of the complete undergraduate final examination schedule appears in the table below. Conflict examinations should not be scheduled; therefore, programs with courses whose final examinations are held at the same time should not be requested.

Weekend Classes: Final examinations will be held on **Saturday and Sunday, December 16 and 17**. Examinations will be held at the regular class meeting times and in the regular classrooms. Generally, exams will last for two hours.
