

DEPARTMENTS OF PSYCHOLOGY AND BIOLOGY INTERDEPARTMENTAL MINOR IN NEUROSCIENCE CHECKLIST

Interdisciplinary minor, offered by the departments of Psychology and Biology, requiring 18-21 credits including 12 advanced credits, each completed with a grade of C- or higher.

At least nine of the advanced credits (courses numbered 3000 and above) must be completed at Brooklyn College.

All courses listed in Group A may be used to satisfy the requirements of both the minor in Neuroscience and the major in Psychology.

Only one course from Group B may be used to satisfy the requirements of both the minor in Neuroscience and the major in Psychology.

Students who do not major in psychology are strongly encouraged to also take Psychology 3400 or Mathematics 4501. It is also highly recommended to take Biology 1001 and Biology 1002.
