The Dance That Escaped - Jervl Johnston

This is an angry thing that got tired of being cooped up and broke itself loose. It may appear that this is a 'classical' piece of music, but that is only a part of the story. The goal of this piece is to get as much rhythm out of a chamber ensemble as possible. The rhythm structure comes, indirectly, from Africa. The Harmony has more to do with jazz than anything else and the recording style is popular, rather than traditional. Someone I know once called it "wacky" and this is my favorite description of it so far.

Originally from Oregon, Jeryl completed a Bachelor of Music Degree at the University of Oregon School of Music with dual majors in Piano Performance and Music Theory. After her degree was complete, she began studying Afro-Cuban music, which took her on an adventure beginning with the salsa bands of Oregon and Washington, through several years playing with Orquesta Son Mayor, among others, in Los Angeles, and which brought her to New York. Since her arrival in New York, Jeryl has worked with many different artists including the Afro Latin Jazz Orchestra, Tipica '73 Charangueando, Louis Bauzo, and the late Ray Santos. She is also the musical director of the Afro-Cuban third stream jazz ensemble Yanine.
