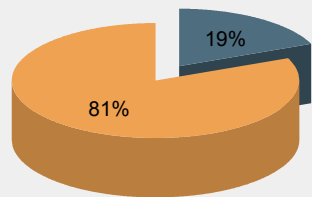

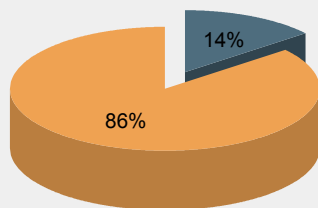
Enrollment FTE Admissions Majors by School

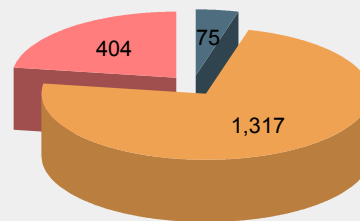

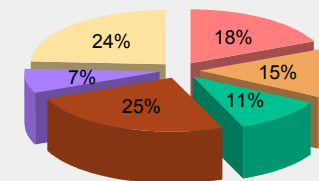

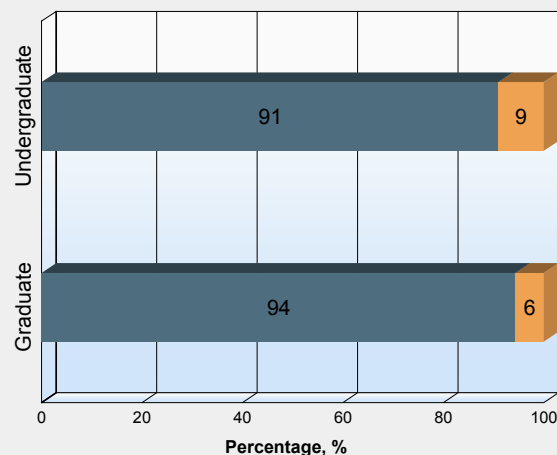

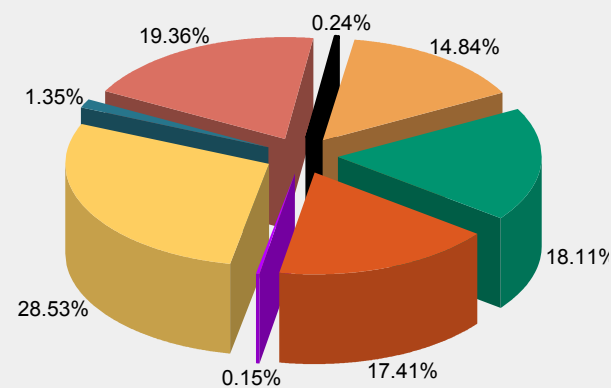

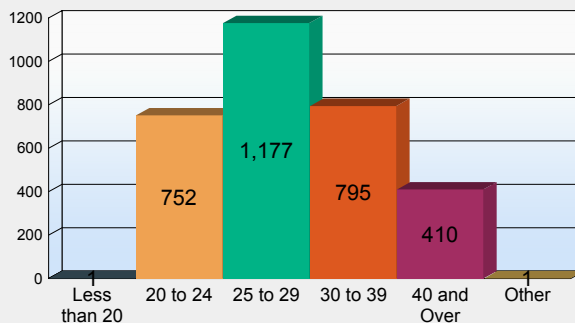
