- Staff Town Hall meeting to solicit feedback on the Brooklyn College Strategic Plan Draft Goals on Thursday, September 7, 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., Jefferson-Williams Room, 4th floor, Student Center.
- Faculty and Student Town Hall meeting to solicit feedback on the Brooklyn College Strategic Plan Draft Goals on Thursday, September 14, 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m., Gold Room, 6th floor, Student Center.

- Town Hall meeting for the entire campus community to give comments on the complete draft of the Brooklyn College Strategic Plan on Thursday, February 15, 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m., State Lounge, 5th floor, Student Center.

March 2018

- Final draft of the Brooklyn College Strategic Plan.

Spring 2018

- We submit the 2018–2023 Brooklyn College Strategic Plan to CUNY for review and approval.
