Judge Patricia M. Martin- Juvenile and Family Justice TODAY

In an article titled, "Judge Martin Speaks on the Epidemic of Violence Against Children at National Forum," Judge Patricia M. Martin, President of the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges, wrote about her presentation with Honorable Judith S. Kaye, retired Chief of the New York State Court of Appeals, at our Social Justice for Children: To End Violence Against Children 20th Anniversary National Consultation held in November 2011.

In the panel presentation titled, "The Courts and the Judiciary: Child Abuse and Violence Against Children," she announced that the "NCJFCJ was among several other organizations and national leaders that signed on to a [our] [joint public statement](#) calling upon national and local organizations, public agencies, and others to 'join forces and work collaboratively toward prevention' and elimination of violence against children in all its forms," which she wrote in the Winter 2012 edition of [Juvenile and Family Justice TODAY](#).
