Professor Gertrud Lenzer, representing the Children's Studies Center for Research, Policy and Public Service, was invited to attend the official Session of the U.S Government Delegation with the U.N. Committee on the Rights of the Child on January 16, 2013 in Geneva, Switzerland.

At the session the Committee on the Rights of the Child discussed with the U.S. Delegation the 2010 U.S. Reports to the Committee on U.S. Implementation of the two Optional Protocols to the Convention on the Rights of the Child- one on the involvement of children in armed conflict, and the other on the sale of children, child prostitution, and child pornography.
