APPLICATION

The Outstanding Senior Award in Children and Youth Studies at Brooklyn College, The City University of New York, recognizes the Children and Youth Studies graduating senior in the academic year 2012 – 2013 who best exemplifies the spirit of scholarship and community commitment that we hope the study of children and youth fosters for our students. The award committee will consider candidates' academic record, their service to the university, and to their community in relation to these values.

Who is eligible? Any Children and Youth Studies major who graduates in either the Fall 2012 or the Spring 2013 semesters.

How do I apply? Applicants must fill out and submit this form, along with the following supporting documents:

- ▶ **Writing sample** from a Children and Youth Studies course that showcases your best work. Include the course title, instructor, and semester the course was taken.
- ▶ **500 - 750 word essay describing:**
 - Why you chose Children and Youth Studies as your major – what life experiences led you to this decision
 - How you plan to apply what you have learned in Children's Studies to your future professional pursuits, academic ambitions and career goals. Explain how Children and Youth Studies was influential in your decision. Your description can include, but should not be limited to, courses, instructors, projects and/or community outreach activities that influenced your decision.

How will the chosen applicant be awarded? A *Certificate of Recognition* at the Children and Youth Studies Commencement Celebration event to be held on Thursday, May 30, 2013 and \$250.

What is the deadline for submitting the application? The application for Outstanding Senior Award is **due by 6:00pm, May 2, 2013. Please submit the application with supporting documents in hard copy only, to Elise Goldberg, Room 1304 James Hall.**
