<u>Intro to Piano</u> Students are introduced to the fundamentals of piano playing in a friendly group environment. Instruction will include beginning note reading and piano technique. Materials fee not included. <i>For age 5 and up</i>	Thursday, 2:30-3:30 Thursday, 3:30-4:30 Saturday, 10:30-11:30 Saturday, 11:30-12:30	\$205 \$205 \$205 \$205
<u>Intro to Suzuki Violin</u> This class is designed to be a child and parent's first experience with the violin and an introduction to the Suzuki method. The child is taught the correct way of holding the violin with no hands (using a cardboard violin), the feet position, and the bow hold. Introduction to 4 basic rhythms. <i>For ages 3 to 6</i>	Saturday, 10:30-11:15 Thursday, 4:45-5:30	\$175 \$175
<u>Intro to Violin</u> Students begin by learning the correct way to hold the violin and bow. Introduction of simple melodies and basic rhythms utilizing a combination of imitation (learning by ear) and basic note reading. <i>For age 6 and up</i>	Saturday, 11:45-12:45 Thursday, 5:30-6:30	\$205 \$205
<u>Intro to Cello</u> Students are introduced to holding the cello, basic technique, the bow hold, note reading and playing with other students. <i>For age 6 and up</i>	Saturday, 10:30-11:30	\$205
<u>Singing Class for Beginners</u> Designed to carefully nurture the voice and using simple songs, this class is designed to provide young voices with basic techniques for breathing, tone, intonation, and good posture. Note reading not required. <i>For age 6 and up</i>	Thursday, 3:30-4:30 Saturday, 11:00-12:00	\$205 \$205
<u>Intermediate Voice Class</u> Students with one or more years of voice study or choral singing work on breathing, tone, intonation, posture, and note reading. <i>For age 8 and up</i>	Saturday, 12:00-1:00	\$205

<u>The Band</u> The band rehearses modern/popular music repertoire. This performance-based class also focuses on recording, rehearsal dynamics and stage etiquette. <i>For age 8 and up</i>	Saturday, 11:00-12:00	\$220
<u>Intro to Trumpet</u> Students are introduced to basic technique, simple melodies, note reading and playing with other students. <i>For age 7 and up</i>	Saturday, 11:00-12:00	\$205
<u>Intro to Flute</u> Students are introduced to the basics of the flute, including breathing, tone production and posture. <i>For age 6 and up</i>	Saturday, 11:00-12:00	\$205
<u>Intro to Clarinet</u> Students are introduced to basic technique, simple melodies, note reading and playing with other students. <i>For age 7 and up</i>	Saturday, 12:00-1:00	\$205
<u>Intro to Saxophone</u> Students are introduced to basic technique, simple melodies, note reading and playing with other students. <i>For age 8 and up</i>	Saturday, 11:00-12:00	\$205
<u>Intro to Guitar</u> Students are introduced to note reading, learning simple melodies, basic chords and chord progressions Please note: students need to bring their own instruments. Materials fee not included. <i>For age 5 and up</i>	Saturday, 1:00-2:00	\$205
<u>Intro to Drum Class</u> Students are introduced to a range of percussion and rhythm instruments. Maximum of 6 students; grouped by age. Materials required – please contact the Prep Center for recommendations. <i>For age 5 and up</i>	Thursday, 4:00-5:00 Saturday, 11:00-12:00 Saturday, 12:00-1:00	\$205 \$205 \$205

Class	Day/Time	Tuition per section
<u>Creative Dramatics for the Very Young</u> Using the child's imagination and creativity, this class uses theater games, movement and song to introduce acting. This class also provides a great opportunity for young children to develop social and communication skills. <i>For ages 3 to 6</i>	Saturday, 3:45-4:30 Tuesday, 3:45-4:30	\$175 \$175
<u>Theater Games and Improvisation</u> Designed for students who are interested in exploring acting in a relaxed and fun-filled environment. An introduction to acting through theater games, monologue, improvisation, and movement. The final class will be a performance open to parents and invited guests. <i>For students ages 6 and up; grouped according to age</i>	Saturday, 1:30-2:45	\$225
<u>Musical Theater Workshop</u> Drawing from classic and current musical theater repertoire, this workshop is designed as an introduction to acting, singing and dancing skills taught collaboratively by two teachers. Emphasis will be placed on developing vocal technique, stage presence and basic musical theater dance choreography in an enjoyable and constructive atmosphere. The final class will be a performance open to parents and invited guests. <i>For ages 6 and up; grouped according to age</i>	Saturday, 11:45-1:15	\$305

DANCE

Dress Requirements for Dance Classes

Itty-Bitty Ballet: leotard, tights and ballet shoes (any color).

Ballet Basics and all other Ballet classes: black or pink leotards, black or pink tights, and pink leather ballet shoes.

Skirts are optional. (Oversized clothing and jewelry are not permitted.)

Jazz/Contemporary Dance: all-black leotards, footless tights, leggings, shorts, t-shirts or tanks. Bare feet (Contemporary), Jazz shoes (Jazz).

Combo Classes, Jump & Move, Hip Hop and Tap: comfortable clothing, sneakers (Jump & Move and Hip-Hop Classes), tap shoes (Tap Class) and ballet & tap shoes (Combo Classes).

<u>Itty Bitty Ballet</u> First ballet class, providing a warm and nurturing environment to encourage the child's love for learning ballet. Development of physical skills through rhythmic and coordination exercises. Introduction to ballet terminology and steps. <i>For ages 3 to 5</i>	Saturday, 9:30-10:15 Thursday, 3:00-3:45	\$175 \$175
<u>Ballet Basics</u> The first class in the Prep Center's progressive Classical Ballet curriculum. Emphasis on beginning to develop ballet technique and learning to work within traditional ballet class structure. <i>For ages 4 to 6</i>	Thursday, 3:30-4:15 Saturday, 10:15-11:00	\$175 \$175
<u>Ballet A</u> Emphasis is placed on ballet technique, ballet vocabulary, and development of correct body alignment. <i>For ages 5 to 9</i>	Saturday, 10:45-11:45 Thursday, 4:15-5:15	\$205 \$205
<u>Ballet B</u> Approval of instructor and minimum of two years of ballet training required. <i>For ages 6-10</i>	Saturday, 10:45-11:45 Thursday, 4:15-5:15	\$205 \$205
<u>Dance Combo I</u> Simultaneous introduction to basic ballet & tap steps, and fundamentals of rhythm and movement. <i>For ages 3-5</i>	Saturday, 2:45-3:45	\$210
<u>Dance Combo II</u> A simultaneous introduction to ballet, jazz and tap. <i>For age 6 and up</i>	Tuesday, 4:45-5:45	\$210
<u>Jump and Move</u> This class will introduce students to hip hop and jazz styles while developing their rhythm, balance, coordination and strength. A high energy class with no prior dance experience necessary. <i>For ages 3 to 8</i>	Tuesday, 3:00-3:45	\$175
<u>Hip Hop</u> Introduction to urban dance. <i>For ages 8 to 12</i>	Thursday, 5:15-6:15	\$205
<u>Tap</u> Introduction to basic tap steps and the fundamentals of rhythm, including essential combinations and their importance to the art of tap dance. No prior dance experience necessary. <i>For age 5 and up</i>	Thursday, 5:15-6:15	\$205
