

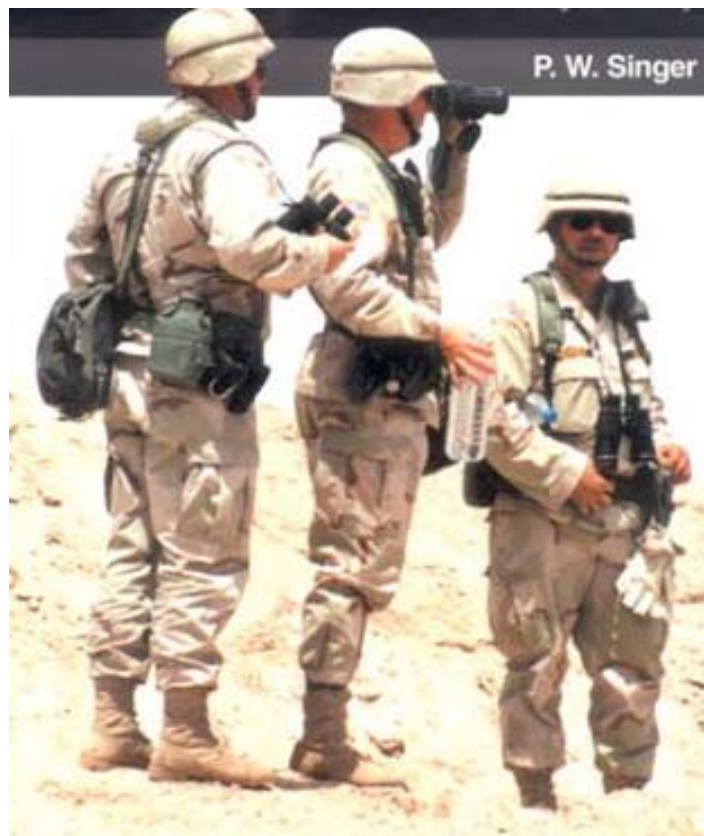

Peter W. Singer is the director of the 21st Century Defense Initiative and a senior fellow in Foreign Policy at The Brookings Institution. Singer's research focuses on three core issues: the future of war, current U.S. defense needs and future priorities, and the future of the U.S. defense system. Singer lectures frequently to U.S. military audiences and is the author of several books and articles, including *Corporate Warriors* and *Children at War*.

Liv Yarrow, associate professor and deputy chair of the Classics Department at Brooklyn College, studied Classics at the George Washington University and at the University of Oxford (MPhil 2000, DPhil 2002). Her research interests are in the areas of Roman and Hellenistic History, especially historiography and numismatics. She is the author of *Historiography at the End of the Republic: Provincial Perspectives on Roman Rule* (2006) and a contributor to the *Roman Provincial Coinage IV Project: The Antonine Period*.
