Marjorie Welsh is the author of several books of poetry, including *The Windows Flew Open* (1991), *Casting Sequences* (1993), *The Annotated "Here" and Selected Poems* (2000), *Word Group* (2004), *Isle of the Signatories* (2008), and, just launched, *Oaths? Questions?*, a collaborative art and poetry project, with James Siena, published by Granary Books. Michael Palmer has said of her poetry: "Very few Americans explore the mechanism of lyric voicing, poetic syntax and poetic logic with [her] determined focus." Ms. Welsh has received grants and fellowships for her poetry, among them: George A. and Eliza Gardner Howard Fellowship, of Brown University, the Judith E. Wilson Visiting Poetry Fellowship, of Cambridge University, and two fellowships from New York Foundation for the Arts. A conference on her writing and art, produced at the University of Pennsylvania in 2002, resulted in the 300-page book, *Of the Diagram: The Work of Marjorie Welsh* (Slough Books, 2003).
