

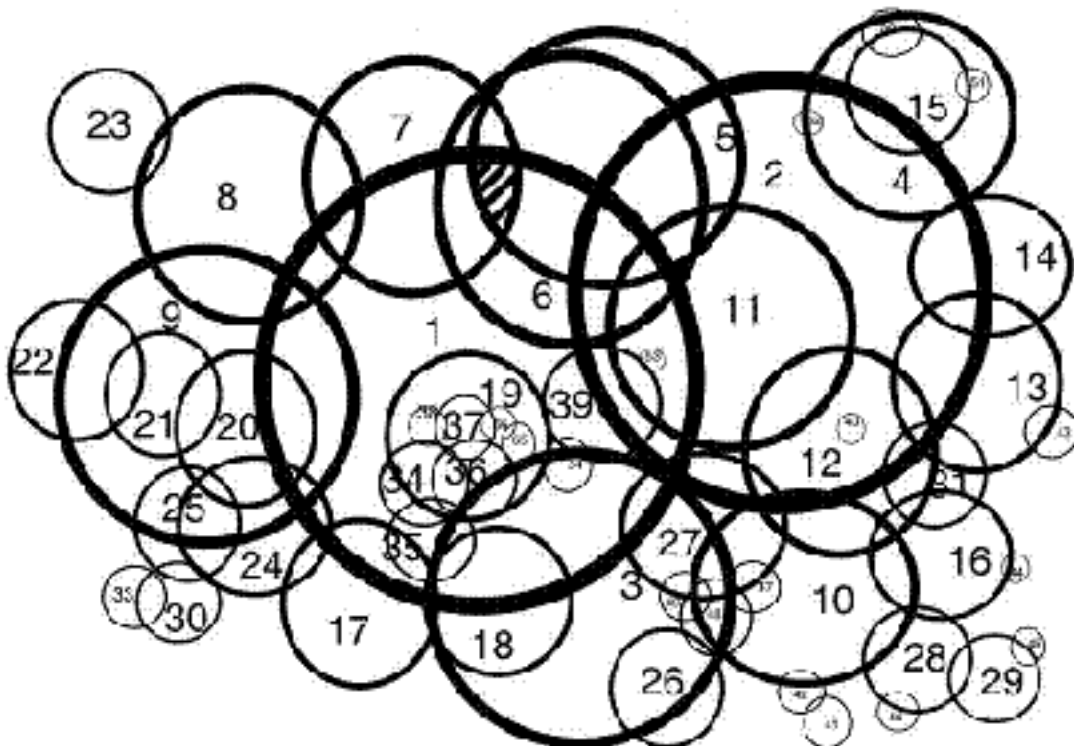

Annette Danto, professor of film, has directed over eighteen films and videos, both fiction and documentary, for non-profit organizations including Gandhigram, UNIFEM, Ted Turner Foundation, and the Pathfinder International. Recent grants include: Eastman Foundation Grant (2007), Tow Faculty Fellowship (2008, 2004), Fulbright Scholar Awards (2004, 2002).

Vinit Parmar, assistant professor of film, received his B.A. from SUNY Buffalo and his J.D. from New York Law School. His film *Black Waters* juried international and regional film festival screenings in 2008 for Outstanding Environmental Vision and won the Katherine Knight Award for Excellence in Documentary on Pollution.
