**Pamela Yates** is the recipient of a 2008 Guggenheim Fellowship. She is the director of the Sundance Award-winning *When the Mountains Tremble*, the producer of the Emmy Award-winning *Loss of Innocence* and the executive producer of the Academy Award-winning *Witness to War*. Previously, Yates directed *State of Fear* (2005).

**Peter Kinoy** has worked in the New York media industry as producer and editor for 25 years. Prior to *The Reckoning*, Kinoy's most recent work was *State of Fear*. Another of his films, *Presumed Guilty*, was broadcast nationally on PBS in the fall 2002 and presented at the Human Rights Watch International Film Festival.

**Paco de Onís** most recent production is *The Reckoning*. Prior to the ICC project, he produced *State of Fear*. De Onís has produced documentaries for PBS (*On Our Own Terms* with Bill Moyers), National Geographic (*Secrets from the Grave*), New York Times Television (*Police Force*, *Paramedics*) and MSNBC (*Edgewise* with John Hockenberry).
