Nominate them! This award (\$5,000) will be presented to a faculty member who has demonstrated excellence in creative or artistic work. Nominees must be full-time faculty members at Brooklyn College during the 2019-2020 academic year. Previous recipients are not eligible.

Nominations are due on **February 11, 2020**. It is easy to nominate. Faculty and administrators can submit names using the <u>online nomination form</u>. The Office of the Associate Provost for Faculty and Administration (APFA) will contact nominees and ask them to provide supporting documents by March 6. Nominators will be asked to write letters of recommendation, also by March 6. Self-nominations are welcome.

By **March 6, 2020**, nominees must submit the following supporting documents to the Office of the Associate Provost in 3227 Boylan Hall:

- 1. curriculum vitae
- 2. statement describing recent creative accomplishments
- 3. examples of creative or artistic work
- 4. evidence of the significance of the work, which can include published reviews and up to three letters from peers
- 5. a paragraph explaining how the nominee would share their expertise with colleagues during the 2020-2021 academic year

E-mailed materials will not be accepted. However, applications can include links to web-based material along with instructions for how to view them.

The associate provost will appoint the selection committee of at least three faculty members, including those who have been recognized for excellence creative or artistic achievement.
