Award for Excellence in Academic Outcomes Assessment

Do you know a faculty member or faculty team who have made an outstanding contribution to academic outcomes assessment? Nominate them! This award (\$2,500) will be presented to a faculty member or faculty team for extraordinary contributions in advancing academic outcomes assessment at Brooklyn College. Nominees must be full-time faculty members at Brooklyn College during the 2020-2021 academic year. Previous recipients are not eligible.

Nominations are due by Friday, **February 19, 2021**. It is easy to nominate. Faculty and academic administrators can submit names using the <u>Online Nomination Form</u>. The Office of the Associate Provost for Faculty and Administration will contact nominees and ask them to provide supporting materials by March 17. Nominators will be asked to write letters of recommendation by March 17. *Self-nominations are welcome*.

By **March 17, 2021**, nominees must submit the following supporting documents to the Office of the Associate Provost electronically via the <u>Dropbox file request</u> specific to this award:

- 1. curriculum vitae (each individual for team nominations)
- 2. statement describing outcomes assessment activities at Brooklyn College (written jointly for team nominations)
- 3. portfolio that includes sample course and/or program assessments
- 4. a paragraph explaining how the nominee or team would promote assessment as a tool to improve student learning among colleagues during the 2021-2022 academic year

E-mailed materials will not be accepted; use the Dropbox link. Applications can include links to web-based material along with instructions for how to view them.

Candidates will be reviewed by faculty representatives serving on the Assessment Council. The Council will recommend finalists to the Academic Affairs Cabinet, who will make the final decision.
