*Notes:

- LOI – Letter of intent, required by some institutions prior to a more detailed agreement. Some institutions call this an MOU (but not CUNY). Current designation is “Statement of Shared Interest (SSI)”.
- MOU – A Memorandum of Understanding, which can take various forms (student exchange, study abroad, faculty exchange, etc.).
- SSI – Statement of Shared Interest. See LOI.
- Student Exchange Agreement – an agreement by which students, faculty or resources are exchanged. At CUNY, different exchanges require different agreements.
- Study Abroad Agreement – CUNY terminology for an agreement that sends students to a host institution abroad.
- In the case where an LOI/SSI was replaced by an exchange or other more specific agreement, that latter agreement type is listed.
