Searching for a Job

The Bureau of Labor (BoL) Statistics Occupational Outlook Handbook provides estimates of the job market growth rate, median salaries, education required and more for many health and other professions. The BoL predicts solid growth in the health care industry in the coming years. You may access the Occupational Outlook Handbook at: <https://www.bls.gov/ooh/healthcare/home.htm>

Some recommendations for starting your job search:

1. Start the search before graduation. It may take months to find a job.
2. Go to the Magner Career Center (1303 James Hall) on campus. The staff can make suggestions about search strategies, including websites to explore. They can also assist you with reviewing your resume and cover letter, as well as practice job interview. Be sure to finalize your resume with them before sending any to employers.
3. When you apply for a job, make sure that the cover letter is tailored to the specific position. A general cover letter will not impress a potential employer. Have someone you know or a staff member at the Magner Career Center proofread your cover letter and resume.
4. Familiarize yourself with online platforms such as LinkedIn, which is one of the most popular and largest professional networks that allows potential job seekers to create a profile that summarizes their professional experiences, skills, and accomplishments. Create a professional profile that matches your resume. This allows you to connect and build your professional network and display your credentials to employers and recruiters. Many employers search and hire potential employees through LinkedIn. Visit www.linkedin.com, and establish a LinkedIn profile.
5. Idealist.org is another online platform, which is based in New York. It helps connect organizations to people seeking jobs. Opportunities include jobs, internships, volunteer experiences, etc.
6. Your fieldwork and volunteer experiences are excellent opportunities to meet future employers.
7. There are too many general employment websites to mention here (e.g., Monster, Idealist, Indeed). Be creative as you search the internet. Ask the staff at the Magner Career Center for advice. You may wish to look at the metropolitan area websites (see below).
8. Let faculty, friends and family know that you are job-hunting.
9. Communicate with academic and professional mentors in your field who can provide you with direction and assistance.
10. Talk to faculty and mentors about letters of recommendation (LOR), which identify your academic performance, skills, and work ethic. Request LORs from faculty who know you well. It is always a good idea to ask for LORs while you are still a student at Brooklyn College.
11. Networking starts while you are in college. Group assignments, lab projects, and student clubs are excellent opportunities to network and showcase your skills. Connect with fellow students on LinkedIn.
12. Depending on your area of interest, take courses in other departments which will help you advance in your job search. For example, you may want to take courses in business if you are interested in health administration. Language ability in Spanish or other languages and computer skills may also be well-regarded.
13. Do not underestimate your background, prior work experience and education.

2. Job Fairs

Job fairs are a great way to explore and learn about multiple employers and companies all at once. Job fairs allow students and employers to meet one another and build professional contacts. Job fairs are commonly held on campus. Bring your resume and dress professionally for job fairs. Be on the lookout!

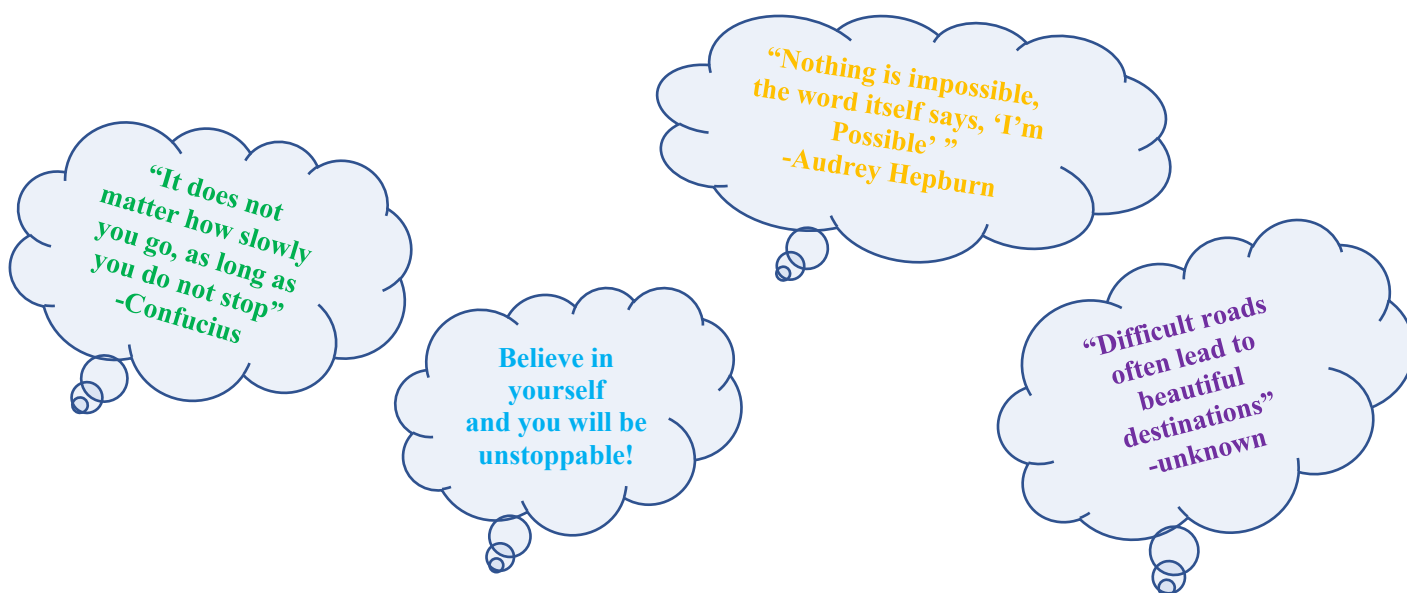
3. Internships and Volunteering

Participating in internships or volunteering can open the door for many opportunities. Internships and volunteer experiences are a great way to build your resume, as well as building your professional network and connections. Some students are even offered full-time positions after they intern or volunteer.

4. Prepare for Interviews

Getting called for an interview may seem exciting, but it will determine if you get the job or not. It is essential that you prepare for an interview. Research the company you are being interviewed for. Dress to impress! Keep in mind, you want to impress the interviewer with your skills and experiences. Be confident!

Selected Career Options for Students with a BA or a BS

Patient Care Advocate	<i>Assists patients in the hospital and health care system.</i>
Health Educator	<i>Promotes healthy lifestyles and behaviors to prevent disease to groups or individuals</i>
Public Health Sanitarian	<i>Performs safety inspections in private businesses, such as restaurants or hotels, as well as public areas, such as parks or pools</i>
Public Health Inspector	<i>Investigates complaints related to health and safety, ensure facilities meet the required standard for public health and safety, provide certifications to facilities that pass tests</i>
Research Assistant	<i>Assists in research in a medical center or university and helps collect, analyze, and interpret information</i>
Healthcare Administrator	<i>Supervises daily activities in health care facilities</i>
Medical Records	<i>Manages medical records</i>
Community Healthcare Worker	<i>Helps improve the health of people in a specific community or region by educating the community about health</i>
Human Resources Specialist	<i>Assists with identifying for new staff within a health care facility</i>
Medical Sales Representative	<i>Responsible for advertising or marketing a company's products, such as medical devices or pharmaceutical drugs</i>
Community Outreach Liaison	<i>Serves communities by providing outreach to ensure the community is aware of the organization's programs and services</i>
Medical Scribe	<i>Works under the supervision of a physician and documents patient history, lab results, etc.</i>

POSITION	RESPONSIBILITIES
Health Communication	<i>Develop and conduct media advocacy and/or health information in various settings, from health departments to community-based grassroots organizations</i>
Industrial Hygienist	<i>Anticipation, recognition, evaluation, and control of occupational health hazards</i>
Social and Community Services Manager	<i>Coordinates and supervises programs that support the public well-being by directing workers to provide those services to the public</i>
Social Worker	<i>Helps people solve and cope with problems in their everyday lives</i>
Substance Abuse, Behavioral Disorders, and Mental Health Counselors	<i>Advises people suffering from drug addiction, alcoholism, or other mental or behavioral problems. Provides support to help clients recover from addiction</i>
Event Planners	<i>Arranges all aspects of events and professional gatherings, such as meeting locations or transportation</i>

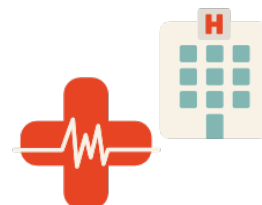
Graduate Programs in Public Health

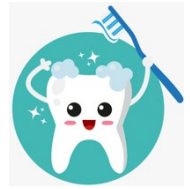
