- Notice the number and locations of the waste and recycling baskets.
- Look at the ventilation and lighting system.

STOP 5: WEST QUAD

The West Quad is across Bedford Ave. Be sure to:

- Take note of the landscape.
 Why is it less popular than the main quad?
- Remember that the West
 Quad Building is actually one
 of the newest yet least
 sustainable buildings on
 campus.





STOP 6: GARDEN

The Garden is a shared with the community.
While here, you should:



- Take photos of the plants
- Notice the size of the garden.
- What are some projects going on here?


STOP 7: CENTRAL PLANT

Instructions

This guide aims to provide an understanding of how sustainability and PlaNYC has shaped the Brooklyn College's campus and goals. This guide will include paths that take you through security check-ins, which will require a CUNY ID. All the stops are all found on or immediately outside the college campus. Bring a camera and a notebook to take notes.







STOP 1: PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

This site is the future home of Brooklyn College's Performing Arts Center. While here, be sure to:

- Take note of the location of the site in relation to the rest of the campus.
- Take pictures of the site, as it will not be long before there is a building here.
- Notice the busy area. Why do you think this location was chosen for the PAC?

STOP 2: SUBO

This is the Student Center, home of the student union and student government. While here, you should:

- Take note of the many different clubs that convene in this place.
- Try to take a look at the lounge area, a common meeting place for students.
- Snap photographs of the building and notice how it blends seamlessly in with its surrounding area, most of which is not the property of Brooklyn College.

STOP 3: BICYCLE RACK

The Bike Rack is an important section of the College as it allows students to have an alternative method of transportation. While at this stop, be sure to:

- Pay attention to the amount of bikes or the racks.
- Notice that the racks are located next to a security booth.

STOP 4: INGERSOLL HALL

Ingersoll is one of the oldest and most sustainable buildings on campus. On the way:

- Take note of the green areas such as the quad and the pond east of the Hall.
