**Johanna Hanink** is professor of classics at Brown University, where she also teaches in the Modern Greek Studies program. Her books include *Lycurgan Athens and the Making of Classical Tragedy* (Cambridge 2014), *The*

*Classical Debt: Greek Antiquity in an Era of Austerity* (Harvard 2017), and a translation of speeches from Thucydides' *History of the Peloponnesian War* (Princeton 2019). Her writing has appeared in *The New York Times*, the *Times Literary Supplement*, and the *Chronicle of Higher Education*. Her edition of translations of works by Andreas Karkavitsas, *The Archeologist and Selected Sea Stories* (2021), marked the first translation of a Greek author from the Greek nation state to appear in the Penguin Classics series. She is co-editor of the *Journal of Modern Greek Studies*.
