PHIL 10: REASONING SPRING 2009 W 6:30-9:00 pm 1455 EW6 Prof. Steinsvold

Course Description and Objectives

What are the best forms of reasoning? Which forms of reasoning should we avoid? What makes some forms of reasoning better than others, and why? These are the types of questions we will be exploring in this class. We will explore the relationship between philosophy and reasoning, discussing a variety of puzzles that have intrigued philosophers. Various forms of logic will be discussed, as well as basic probability, some statistics, psychology, social psychology, amongst other topics.

Grading: Three Exams, Class Participation, and Attendance There will be three major exams, each worth 33 % of your grade

Do them. Overall, I hope you feel encouraged to participate. Class discussion makes everything more interesting. A lack of class participation will not negatively affect your grade (unfair to penalize the quiet). Class participation may involve presenting your answers to homework questions at the board. Being late, especially being continually late, will take away from your class participation points. Being late means arriving after attendance has been taken. If you arrive late, inform me after class to mark you as late. As I understand it, past a certain point I am allowed to fail the student for excessive absences. Hopefully it wont come to that. If you miss an exam there will be some penalty to your grade of this exam (once taken).
