Anti-vaxxers, Flat-Earthers, 'Fake News', or Why We are Failing Epistemology

A growing lack of trust in science, in the existence of facts, experts, and other reliable sources has led to, among other things, the rise of previouslycontrolled (or eliminated) diseases due to vaccination refusal, creating a rapidly-developing public health crisis in the United States and elsewhere. As a result of this conspiratorial turn in public discourses, what we have is an epistemic crisis with very real, life-threatening consequences.
