The word 'sex' designates two large areas of concern: sex as dimorphism and erotic sex. Philosophers' first concern is with definition and analysis: what actually are sex and gender, and what precisely is erotic sex? In this talk, I'll give two examples: one concerns sexual dimorphism; the second concerns the relation between what is "natural" and what is generally considered "normal" or even "moral" in matters of erotic sex. Both have important consequences for sociopsychological issues that have aroused powerful political passions.
