Level 1

- ☐ Film 1101 – Language of Film I
- ☐ Film 1201 – Introduction to Production
- ☐ Film 1301 – Screenwriting I

These three courses may be taken concurrently. However, students are not permitted to take only Film 1101 and 1201; students must have either completed, or must be taking Film 1301 concurrently with Film 1201.

Level II

- ☐ Film 2401– Directing Workshop I (*Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301*)
- ☐ Film 2501 – Cinematography Workshop I (*Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301*)
- ☐ Film 2601 – Location Sound (*Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301*)
- ☐ Film 2701- Editing (*Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301*)

Level III

- ☐ Film 3300W – The Qualifying Film: Screenplay (*Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301; may be taken concurrently with Film 2401, 2501, 2601, 2701*)
- ☐ Film 3200 – The Qualifying Film: Production (*Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301, 2401, 2501, 2601, 2701, **3300W** and permission of the instructor*)
- ☐ Film 3700 –The Qualifying Film: Post-production (*Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301, 2401, 2501, 2601, 2701, **3200, 3300W** and permission of the instructor*)
