Level 1
☐ Film 1101 – Language of Film I
☐ Film 1201 – Introduction to Production
☐ Film 1301 – Screenwriting I
These three courses may be taken concurrently. However, students are not permitted to take only Film 1101 and 1201; students must have either completed, or must be taking Film 1301 concurrently with Film 1201.

☐ Film 3300W – The Qualifying Film: Screenplay (Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301; may be taken concurrently with Film 2401, 2501, 2601, 2701)
☐ Film 3200 – The Qualifying Film: Production (<i>Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301, 2401, 2501, 2601, 2701, 3300W and permission of the instructor)</i>
☐ Film 3700 –The Qualifying Film: Post-production (<i>Prerequisite: Film 1101, 1201, 1301, 2401, 2501, 2601, 2701, 3200, 3300W and permission of the instructor)</i>
