

Screenwriting Major Requirements (043):

Level 1

- ☐ Film 1101– The Language of Film
- ☐ Film 1201 – Introduction to Production
- ☐ Film 1301 – Screenwriting 1

These three courses may be taken concurrently. However, students are not permitted to take only Film 1101 and 1201; students must have either completed, or must be taking Film 1301 concurrently with Film 1201.

Level II

- ☐ Film 2301 Screenwriting II – (*Prerequisites: Film 1101, 1201, **1301** with grade of B or higher, one film studies course and permission of the instructor.*)
- ☐ Film 3301 Screenwriting III (*Prerequisites: Film 1101, 1201, **1301**, **2301** with a grade of B or higher, at least two upper-level film studies elective; and permission of the instructor*)

Level III

- ☐ Film 4301–Screenwriting IV (*Prerequisites: Film 1101, 1201, **1301**, **2301**, **3301**, senior status, and permission of the instructor.*)

Film Studies Requirements

- ☐ Film 2115– History of Film I (1895-1941) (*Prerequisite: Film 1101*)
- ☐ Film 2116 – History of Film II (1941-present) (*Prerequisite: Film 1101*)
- ☐ Film 3101W – The Language of Film II (Writing Intensive, *prerequisites: Film 1101, ENGL 1010 &1012*)

Film and Writing Course Requirements

Students concentrating in screenwriting must take two additional major courses, **one** of which one may be taken outside the department, chosen from the following: English 3306, Television and Radio 2616, 3661, 3662, or 3850, or Theater 1101.
