



Students who were accepted through our Admissions Office and who have not attended Brooklyn College for one or more semesters and wish to register must apply for readmission.

If you fall into any of the categories below, you *cannot* submit this Readmission Application and must apply through the Office of Admissions.

1. You *never* attended Brooklyn College's Undergraduate or Graduate Programs
2. You *only* attended as a visiting student.
3. You *only* attended as a high school student.
4. You *only* participated in the UFT program.
5. You were classified as a nonmatriculated/nondegree graduate student who has not been in continuous enrollment.
6. You have already earned a graduate degree from Brooklyn College.
7. You are enrolled in a graduate program at Brooklyn College but wish to switch to a different program.
8. You wish to *change* your matriculation status.

Once you are accepted and registered, a \$20 Readmission Fee will appear on your bill. This fee is nonrefundable and cannot be transferred to another semester.

Any changes to your academic record or GPA that occur after you have submitted the Readmission Application must be reported. We will not be responsible for any consequences if you are negligent in reporting a change.
