\*Commitment deposit waiver eligibility: The commitment deposit will be waived for veterans of the U.S. military armed forces. For educational purposes, veteran status is different than for Veterans Administration (VA) purposes.

You are a veteran for educational purposes if you:

1. Have engaged in active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, or Coast Guard), or are a National Guard or Reserve enlistee who was called to active duty for other than state or training purposes, or were a cadet or midshipman at one of the service academies, and
2. Either 'a' or 'b'
  - a) Were released under a condition other than dishonorable discharge and had been engaged in active duty for at least one day. The release condition is the 'character of service' on the DD-214: Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty, or
  - b) Are still on active duty and will be released by June 30th of the school year
