Memory Match Game

Print two copies of this sheet (heavy paper works best) and cut out the pictures along the guidelines. Shuffle the cards and lay them on the table, face down, in rows. On each turn, a player turns over any two cards, one at a time. If the cards match, the player gets to keep the pair, and that player gets another turn. When a player turns over two cards that do not match, those cards are turned face down again (in the same position) and it becomes the next player's turn. The trick is to remember which cards are where. The person with the most pairs at the end of the game wins.
