B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM

- Completion of the A.A. degree in Modern Languages with a Specialization in Spanish and a minimum GPA of 2.00
- Grade of C or better in freshman composition, its equivalent, or a higher-level English course
- Successful completion of a 3-credit college-level math course

Please Note: Students are guaranteed 60 credits, but may transfer more into Brooklyn College. Students must earn a minimum of 120 credits, with at least 30 of those credits taken at Brooklyn College.

Total additional credits required at the senior college to complete baccalaureate degree: 60

Total credits required to complete the baccalaureate degree: 120

C. TRANSFER CREDIT AWARDED

Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC) graduates who complete the Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree in Modern Languages with a specialization in Spanish will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Arts (B.A) degree in Spanish at Brooklyn College.

1. *Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:*

When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by representatives from each institution's respective departments, selected by their chairpersons/program directors.


2. *Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:*

Each semester Brooklyn College will provide BMCC with the following information: a) the number of BMCC students who applied to the program; b) the number of BMCC students who were accepted into the program; c) the number of BMCC students who enrolled; and d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students.


3. *Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, Websites, etc.:*
