Admission Requirements to Senior College Program:

Completion of the A.S. degree. Pursuant to University policy, students who have earned a City University Associate in Science (A.S.) degree will be deemed to have automatically fulfilled the lower division liberal arts and science distribution requirements for a baccalaureate degree (Core Curriculum lower-tier courses plus English composition and Speech, if necessary, at Brooklyn College). Students will be required to complete two upper division (upper-tier) Core Curriculum courses from two (2) of the three (3) groups of courses approved effective September 2006.

Also, graduates of the A.S. degree program who have not completed at least one year of foreign language study (or established an equivalent proficiency) may be asked to complete up to nine (9) credits of foreign language coursework (or establish an equivalent proficiency) in addition to their normal degree requirements. Proficiency may be established based upon high school coursework, native language abilities, or examination.

Monitoring, Evaluation, and Modification of this Agreement

This agreement will be monitored by tracking students as they progress through the sequence of upper division courses upon transfer. Academic performance and persistence towards the baccalaureate degree will be evaluated by the Director of the Communication Program at BC and the relevant faculty members in the Department of Communications and Performing Arts at KCC, including the Department Chair. The Communication Program at BC and the department at KCC will consult with each other about course sequencing, student achievement, prerequisites, and the like.


Dissemination of the Agreement

Effective Date of Agreement: September 1, 2007 (pending final approval of B.A. program)




