Admission Requirements to Senior College Program:

Completion of the A.S. degree. Pursuant to University policy, students who have earned a City University Associate in Science (A.S.) degree will be deemed to have automatically fulfilled the lower division liberal arts and science distribution requirements for a baccalaureate degree (Core Curriculum lower-tier courses plus English composition and Speech, if necessary, at Brooklyn College). Students will be required to complete two upper division (upper-tier) Core Curriculum courses from two (2) of the three (3) groups of courses approved effective September 2006.

Also, graduates of the A.S. degree program who have not completed at least one year of foreign language study (or established an equivalent proficiency) may be asked to complete up to nine (9) credits of foreign language coursework (or establish an equivalent proficiency) in addition to their normal degree requirements. Proficiency may be established based upon high school coursework, native language abilities, or examination.

Information about the articulation agreement will be made available in the BC Undergraduate Bulletin (including the electronic version on the college website) as well as the KCC bulletin, on the BC Department of Television and Radio website, and at the admissions information center and student advisement center of both colleges. The Communication Program at BC will develop a brochure about the Program (and referencing this articulation agreement) to be disseminated at both colleges and in outside recruiting efforts.
