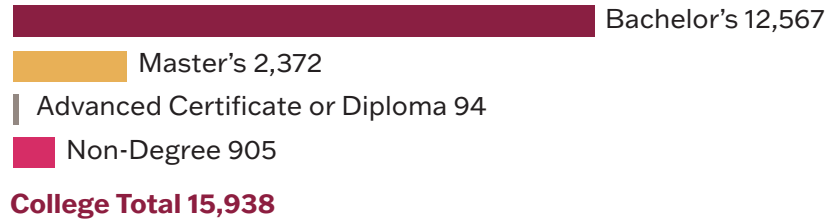

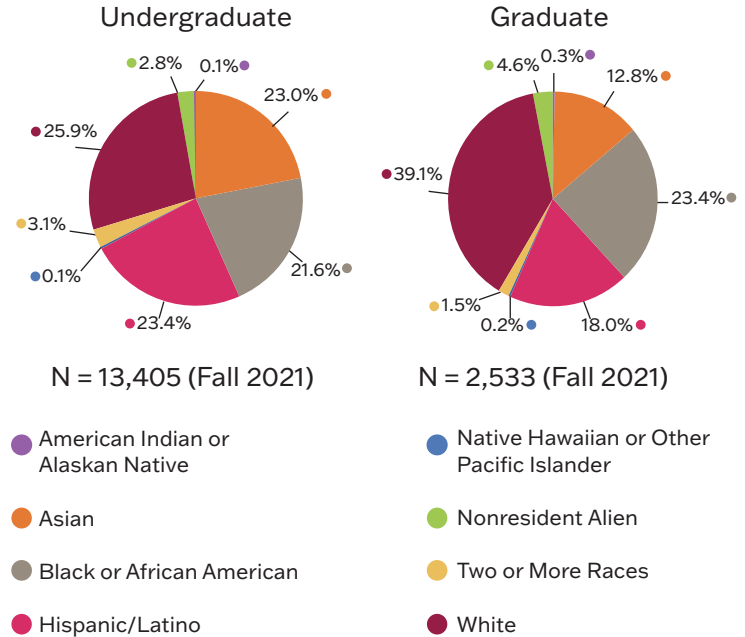

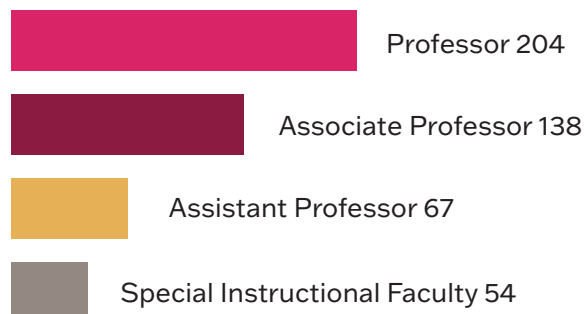
Student Body Ethnic/Racial Diversity

Full-time Faculty Size, Fall 2021



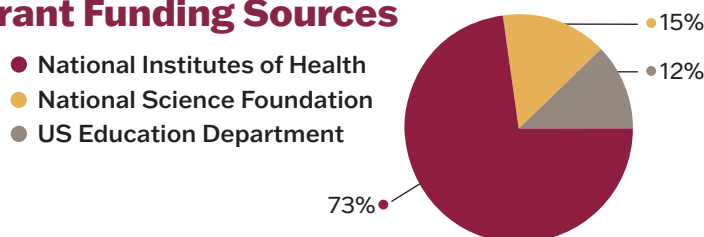

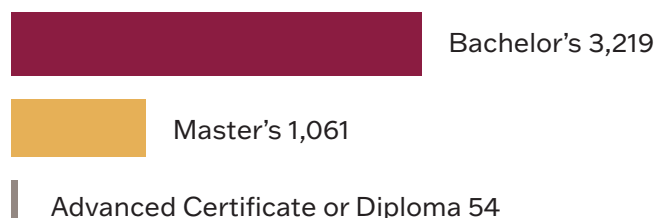

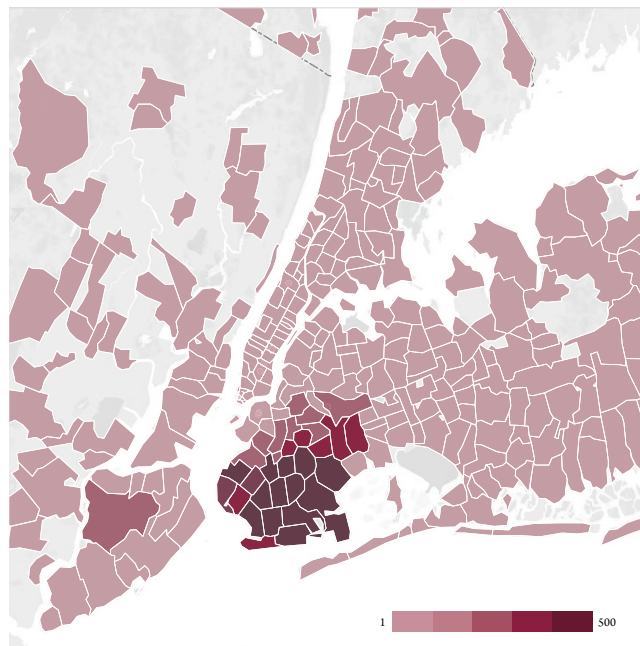
