

The Brooklyn College Wall of Fame

Brooklyn College is committed to academic excellence, fostering a student-centered campus and being a model citizen in the borough of Brooklyn and broader community. To that end the college has established the Student Wall of Fame; which will feature actively purposeful individuals who demonstrate characteristics that further the mission and goals of Brooklyn College. Wall of Fame applicants will be reviewed and chosen by a selection committee appointed by the Vice President for Student Affairs.

The Wall of Fame program focuses on student leadership, personal development and good academic standing. Honorees will represent Brooklyn College's standards of inclusion, achievement and excellence.

Candidates for recognition may include:

- Students who achieve success by overcoming challenges in unique ways.
- Students who are recognized by accredited organizations external to the college.
- Students who successfully engage in leadership or civic activities that impact a significant part of the Brooklyn College community.
- **All graduate and undergraduate students are eligible to apply.**

Expectations of all Honorees:

- It is expected that applicants will or have participated in 3 co-curricular workshops/sessions throughout the semester as sponsored by CLASE, Magner Center, etc.
- All honorees will be held to appropriate standards of professional conduct.

Rewards and Recognition:

The photo and story of each honoree will be placed in the Wall of Fame located in the Boylan Hall Cafeteria and on the web. In addition, honorees will be eligible for the following:

- A certificate of service and recognition at the annual Student Affairs Conference
- Student Leadership Development opportunities (modules and workshops).
- Opportunities to participate in college wide committees, conferences, scholarships.

Honorees may be invited to participate in:

- Open houses and fairs
- National, state or city events
- Borough wide hearings
- Civic breakfasts
- Greeting new faculty and staff
- Conferences
- Community tours
- Serve on committees

Application Process:

Students may apply once per academic year:

1. Complete the application form. Demographic information on the form is confidential and will not be used as criteria for recognition.
2. Write a personal statement answering the questions below. The statement should be at least 300 words, typed, double spaced, 12pt font, 1" margins. Include your name at the top of each page.
 - a. Describe a unique accomplishment or success and how it shaped you.
 - b. Discuss your leadership or civic activities and how they impact a significant part of the Brooklyn College community.
 - c. State your career and academic goals.
3. Please submit the name and telephone number of **two** references that can speak to your qualifications for the BC Wall of Fame.
4. Include a current résumé.
