- Advocates for a supportive and safe campus environment

Excellence in Community

- Demonstrates a spirit of active leadership in building community
- Promotes students-community collaborative programming on campus

Excellence in Diversity

- Through actions and activities fosters learning, reflection, and respect for difference
- Incorporates the principles of diversity and inclusion into aspects of programs and activities
- Actively strives to create opportunities for interaction between and among diverse groups

Excellence in Learning

- Supports awareness of global issues and connection to individuals' lives
- *Has a positive impact on student learning, retention and/or success*
- *Promotes faculty-student collaborative programming on campus*

Nomination Process:

- 1. Describe, in writing, (500 words or less) the accomplishments of the nominee and why you feel recognition is deserved.
- 2. Typed nominations, including nominee's full name and best contact information, must be submitted via e-mail to <u>civicengagement@brooklyn.cuny.edu</u>

3. Deadline for Nominations: March 23, 2015

Candidates will be chosen by a committee representing faculty, staff, and students appointed by the Vice President for Student Affairs. The awards will be presented at the *Make A Difference Dinner on April 15, 2015 from 6* – *8pm, Student Center Gold Room.*
