

• Apply for Federal Financial Aid

Complete the 2017-2018 FAFSA application at www.fafsa.ed.gov Brooklyn College school code: 002687

• Apply for State Financial Aid

For NY State Residents: after completion of your FAFSA, click on the "Start Your State Application" link to complete the 2017-2018 TAP application. The direct link to the TAP application is: <u>https://www.tap.hesc.ny.gov/totw/</u> Brooklyn College school code: 1410

• Excelsior Scholarship

This year, Governor Cuomo and the New York State Legislature enacted a new scholarship program to help middle-class families pay for college. Named the Excelsior Scholarship, it pays any remaining tuition charges after the student's other grants and scholarships have been applied. The scholarship program is designed to promote on-time graduation while reducing college loan debt. The application is managed by New York State's Higher Education Services Center (HESC). The deadline for the Excelsior Scholarship Program was midnight Friday, July 21, 2017: https://www.hesc.ny.gov/excelsior/

• Review your CUNYfirst To Do List

• Review your Financial Aid awards on your CUNYfirst account

Utilize the "Account Inquiry" link to review aid that has been authorized and applied to your tuition as pending financial aid.

• Enroll in Direct Deposit

You can sign up for direct deposit via CUNYfirst to have your financial aid refunds electronically deposited into your bank account. To add a bank account, log into CUNYfirst, navigate to Self Service > Campus Finances > Manage My Bank Accounts: www.cuny.edu/studentrefunds

• Fill out your CUNY Supplement Form

To be considered for Supplemental Financial Aid such as Aid for Part Time Studies (APTS), complete the 2017-2018 CUNY Supplement Form online on CUNYfirst. The online application is available on your Student Center under "Finances".

Transfer Students

Students entering Brooklyn College with 60 or more transfer credits must declare a major using BC WebCentral Portal <u>https://portal.brooklyn.cuny.edu</u> before the deadline (see college Calendar for deadline). Majors must be declared online. Seek academic advisement from your chosen Major Department for classes to take; certain Majors require departmental approval. Transfer students must ensure that transfer credits are properly evaluated, as this may impact eligibility of the NYS TAP award.
