

Undergraduate Final Examination Schedule Spring 2017

Final examinations for the spring 2017 semester will be held from **Saturday, May 20, through Friday, May 26**. Final examinations have been scheduled based on uniform examinations (in the bold print below) and the section of the course. A copy of the complete undergraduate final examination schedule appears in the table below. **Conflict examinations should not be scheduled; therefore, programs with courses whose final examinations are held at the same time should not be requested.**
