




LIBRARY TOWER & CUPOLA RENOVATION

- Originally erected between 1935-1937.
- All designs were based off the original drawings (1939) and archival photos.



LIBRARY TOWER AND CUPOLA RENOVATION



PHASE I:Tower Restoration

Repaired the inside and outside (from the cupola down). Gilded the gold on the cupola (not the dome).

PHASE II: Structural Repairs

Restored the structural integrity of the aging tower. Completed the inside of the cupola.

PHASE III: In Progress

(Anticipated completion date of November 10, 2020) Completing windows, roof repair, and adding colored lights. The lighting can be adjusted for holidays or events.












The historic unveiling of the newly restored tower and cupola will be phased.




INGERSOLL EXTENSION ROOF REPLACEMENT

The complete replacement of a 30-year old slate roof, chimneys, and the center tower. This will resolve a leaking flat roof.

INGERSOLL HALL UPGRADES: INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES

- Laboratory fume hood exhaust upgrade throughout New Ingersoll.
- The new exhaust system eliminates the fume hood shutdowns for exhaust fan maintenance.
- New electrical switchgear room, emergency generator, retrofit of acid neutralization system.



This is a new fan exhaust system (lab fume hoods).







ARAMARK ASSET INVENTORY

Project: Tagging/inventory survey of all mechanical equipment (about 95% complete)

Goal: Ensure our equipment operates in a manner that best satisfies the needs of the occupants and/or space function; Identify operational improvements (e.g. tune ups); Introduce cost-effective solutions; Improve occupant comfort, reduce building energy intensity and maintenance costs.

INGERSOLL & ROOSEVELT HALL PLANNING STUDY

Project: A multi-phased capital improvement project to enhance Ingersoll and Roosevelt Hall. **Goals:** (I) A technical assessment of these spaces to identify programmatic needs. This assessment will determine a phasing plan for this project; (2) Phased design & construction


